- 1) Write the names of any three important regions out of which Allama Iqbal, in his Allah Abad's address of 1930, put forward the concept of a Muslim state by combining them.
- 2) Which viceroy announced the elections to be held in December 1945 in India? On which slogans did the Congress and Muslim League contest the elections?
- 3) When did the executive council of Muslim League decide to be part of the interim government? Write down two reasons of Quaid-e-Azam's rejecting the Cabinet Mission?
- 4) Write the name of the lowest mountain range of Himalayas. Name two of the features that make Himalayan kabir beautiful.
- 5) What percentage of Pakistan's area is covered by forests? Write down two important features of coastal forests.
- 6) Write down two qualities of Belle Forest wood. What is its wood used for?
- 7) To which problem, paring canals and installing tube wells is the solution? Write down the names of any two environmental issues.
- 8) When was the first constitution of Pakistan enacted? Write any two of the human rights recognized in this constitution.
